Hi Seth, Good meeting you yesterday. Here is the memo I said I would send you summarizing the national poll, which was presented to EPA staff on Monday. We would be happy to do another briefing on the national poll results if that would be helpful. This memo is confidential.

Someone yesterday asked the question of how ALA ranked as a messenger and I couldn't remember the results off the top of my head. Here they are as outlined in this memo.

"Supporters of stronger pollution limits have more credibility than opponents. President Obama (49% positive, 36% negative) and the EPA (39%, 22%) are viewed more favorably than Republicans in Congress (35%, 37%). In addition, the people and organizations voters are most likely to say they trust for "information on EPA air pollution standards" include:
